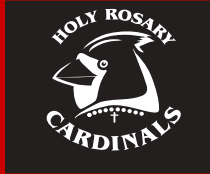

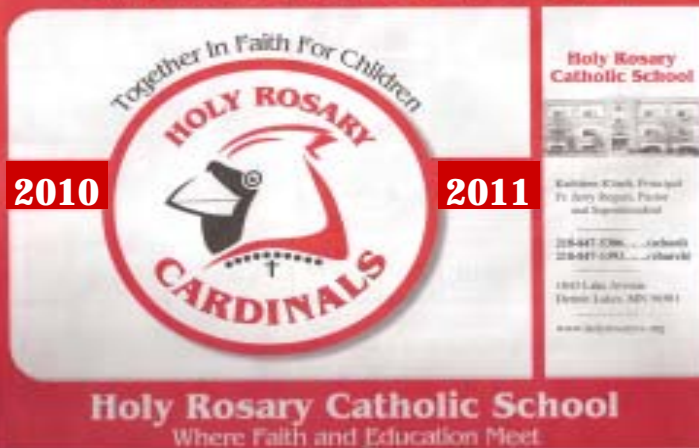

Do you want to advertise in our new calendar? We sell about 1,000 calendars every year. It is an inexpensive way to advertise, and it helps with the printing expenses of the calendar. We recommend \$150 and your logo is printed 12 times throughout the calendar.

For those who don't know about this special calendar, it is a raffle calendar that sells for \$25. Holy Rosary School has been selling these calendars for over 30 years. It is a wonderful fundraiser. *Each day July through January there is a winner!* You can win \$25, \$75, \$250 OR \$500! Plus, you can win more than once. Once a winner is drawn, the winner goes back in the drawing. The daily drawings begin on July 1, 2010 and go until January 31, 2011. We give out over \$11,000 in prizes and we earn about \$13,000 for our school.

• **Campbell's UPC Codes and Our Family UPC Codes**

• **We Care Receipts**

Get your receipt stamped with the WE CARE stamp when shopping at Central Market. 1% of the receipt total is donated to our school.

• **Box Tops for Educations**

Clip all Box Tops for Education and turn into our school. Each Box Top is worth 10 cents!

• **Aluminum Cans- Minnkota Recycling**
