# The Big Twenty!

**Each family is required to earn \$500 by fundraising every year!**

1. Selling Raffle Calendars— We have new calendars printed every year and sell them for \$25 each. Buyers are eligible for daily cash drawings. Winners may win \$25—\$500! You can also win more than once. The calendars will be distributed before Easter to sell. The raffle begins July 1 and ends January 31. *\$20 per calendar sold*
2. Marathon—September & October - The Annual Marathon for Nonpublic Education is to raise funds for our school. Students, parents, teachers, and friends will seek pledges and walk, bike, roller blade or jog 11 miles around Big and Little Detroit Lakes. Students receive pledge sheets and visit, call, or write their family and friends to explain their participation in the marathon, which is to raise money for our school. Our Marathon Kick-Off day is the beginning of September and parents are welcome to attend. Students receive great prizes! All money that is pledged is credited toward the student's commitment. Helping the day of the event by working at various jobs such as patrolling, serving luncheon, clean-up, registering marathoners, helping collect and distribute prizes, and helping to count money, and helping with the Kick-off or at the Awards. Our goal is to raise over \$30,000.  
*\$1 per marathon dollar earned. \$10 per hour worked.*
3. Spring Interlude Dinner/Auction/Dance—Each year we hold the annual “Spring Interlude” fundraiser for the music and the art programs for the parish and school. Taking place in the spring of the year, the events consist of a dinner, auction, raffle, and dance. Tickets are \$50 per person and entitle the buyer to a wonderful meal, a chance to the grand prize (which can be a cash prize and/or a great vacation), plus a night of entertainment. Includes the Fun Raffle, \$5 per ticket. Our goal for this year's Spring Interlude is \$40,000! Join in the fun and help with this great event. *\$5 per fun raffle ticket sold/\$10 per hour worked/\$500 per chairperson.*
4. Parish Festival – August—This is the biggest event of the year for our parish. This event is held at the City arena and usually begins with an outdoor Mass. The day proceeds with games, bingo, raffles, wonderful selections of food, entertainment and a huge live and silent auction. There's something for everyone! It takes a lot of people—power to make this a success. *\$10 per hour worked/\$500 per chairperson.*
5. Gift Cards For Sale! We are able to purchase gift cards/certificates at a discount and resell them at full face value. The school retains the profit from the gift certificates. This fundraiser does not cost anyone a cent more than spent. The only difference is you shop with gift cards/certificates instead of cash. So, if you are planning to go shopping or need a gift for a friend, stop by the parish office or complete the order form to purchase your certificates. *Earn points for shopping! \$25 per \$50 spent in gift cards.*
6. UPC Codes from Campbell's Labels. Clip and save! *\$500 per chairperson*
7. Our Family Products. Clip and save! *\$500 per chairperson*
8. Box Tops for Education Labels. Clip and save! *\$500 per chairperson*

10. Kemps and Land O Lakes Milk Caps for 5 cents each. *\$500 per chairperson.*
11. Playground, Lunchroom, Lunch server Volunteers. Help supervise students during recess or lunchroom. Help the cooks serve lunch. One hour per day, 1 or more days per week, your choice! 11:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. for playground and 11:15 a.m. - 12:15 p.m. for lunchroom.  
*\$500 per year or \$10 per hour.*
12. Christmas Program - December Every December we have a wonderful performance by the entire school. This performance has many areas of production needing volunteers to assist with costumes, scenery, refreshments, etc... *\$10 per hour.*
13. Scholastic Book Fair – March or April just before Easter. Workers are needed to help set up, sell and put away.
14. PTO Teacher Appreciation. The PTO (Parent-Teacher Organization) appreciates our teachers for their commitment to Holy Rosary Catholic School. Each year something special is planned to appreciate our teacher. *\$10 per hour*
15. Volunteer Work—Coaching sports, secretarial or classroom help, volunteer driving, any other family donation of time, talent, or treasure. *\$10 per hour/\$500 per chairperson.*
16. Recruit a family to Holy Rosary School and *automatically earn \$100.* Please complete form in school office for verification.
17. PTO Yearly parent/class assigned events—In an effort to involve a greater number of parents and teachers in the Holy Rosary School Parent Teacher Organization (PTO), we have assigned certain school events to be organized by specific grades. Being a member of the PTO and participation in these events is an integral part of belonging to the Holy Rosary School family. Parents are responsible for helping with the event that has been assigned to their child’s grade level. *\$10 per hour.*
